

P-TECH Construction

What is P-TECH Construction?

P-TECH is a partnership between Western Colorado Community College, FCI Contractors, Inc. and the D51 Career Center. The goal is to provide students with an opportunity to earn an associate degree at the same time as earning their high school diploma, and work experience. Students can enter P-TECH as a 9th, 10th, or 11th grader and the program is designed to be completed in 4 to 6 years. P-TECH students take traditional high school courses, D51 Career Center Construction Technology course(s), P-TECH specific courses, and have opportunities to participate in apprenticeship programs and job shadows.

The D51 Career Center's partnership role is to support the Construction P-TECH program by offering district wide enrollment within the Colorado Career and Technical Education (CTE) <u>secondary pathway of</u>

<u>Construction Technology</u> at the D51 Career Center campus, a recognized <u>Designated Career and Technical School (DCTS)</u> by the Colorado Department of Education.
